



Application for Girl Delegate Positions

As a Girl Scout, age 14 and older, you are eligible to apply for the position of Girl Delegate, which is an official voting member of GSEP's Delegate Council. As a Delegate, you have an opportunity to provide valuable feedback to the Board and be part of the Governance process.

Girl Delegates are required to travel to three meetings a year. The Fall and Spring Delegate meetings are held locally in two locations. The Annual Council meeting is held council-wide in a central location. Delegates are expected to be open-minded, good communicators and expected to:

- Share their knowledge with girls and adults involved in Girl Scouting;
- Talk to girl and adult members to learn their opinions about governance issues important to Girl Scouts;
- Share their opinions and suggestions in a positive and collaborative fashion at Delegate Meetings.

Interested girls must complete this application and provide one reference from an unrelated adult. **Application must be received via email or postmarked by Wednesday, December 21, 2011. Please reach out to your references as soon as possible so they are able to meet the deadline.** You may be contacted for an interview or additional information after you application is received. If you are currently serving as a Girl Delegate serving your first or second terms, you are eligible to be nominated for another term.
