



Application for Girl Advisor to the Board of Directors Position

The position of **Girl Advisor** to the Board of Directors is a leadership opportunity for a current 10th and 11th grade Girl Scout to participate in the responsibilities of the Board and provide girls' perspectives on policy decisions to the Board. The position is a non-voting position and nominees will be elected by GSEP's Delegate Council at the Annual Meeting on April 21, 2012.

Interested girls must complete this application and provide two references from unrelated adults. (One reference must be from an adult volunteer in Girl Scouting and one from another adult.) **The application must be received via email or postmarked by Wednesday, December 21, 2011. Please reach out to your references as soon as possible so they are able to meet the deadline.** You may be contacted for an interview or additional information after your application is received.

Girl Advisors are also voting members of GSEP's Delegate Council and girls may hold only one Delegate position at a time. If you apply for a Girl Advisor position and are not selected, you will be considered for a Girl Delegate position.
