



Let's start with Clover's story!

























Just then, Clover's friend Henry flew over, carrying several jars.






What do you think would have happened to the leftover yogurt and apples if Clover hadn't suggested making a dip?

Let's launch what you learned into starting to use resources more wisely!


2) Reuse when you can
