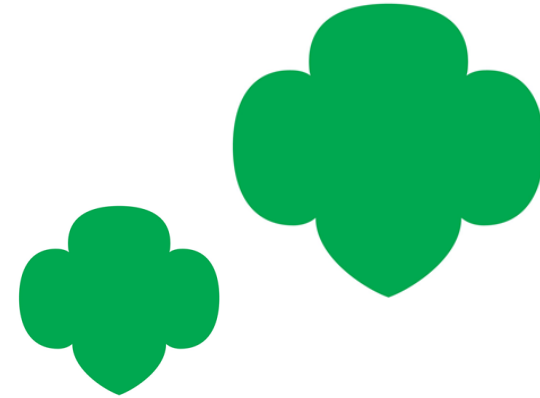

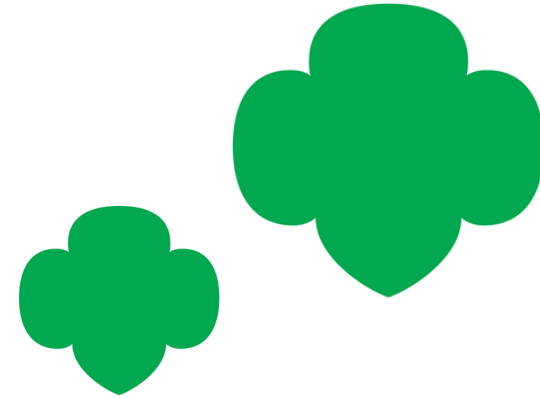

- 5. Practice being at ease*



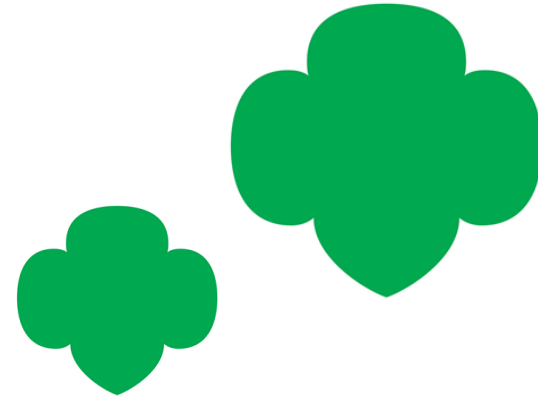
Hold a Conversation

Helpful Tips to Hold a Conversation!

- ✚ Talk about things you are passionate about: activities, hobbies, projects, goals, ideas or jobs.

- ✚ Listen don’t just continue to talk over the other person
- ✚ Try not to “Blurt” out.. What does it mean to Blurt?
 - ✚ saying whatever you’re thinking about in that moment

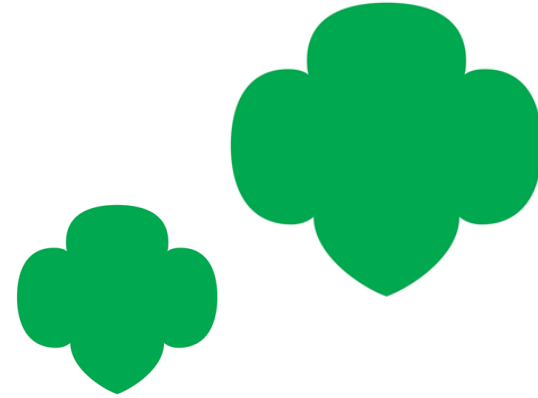

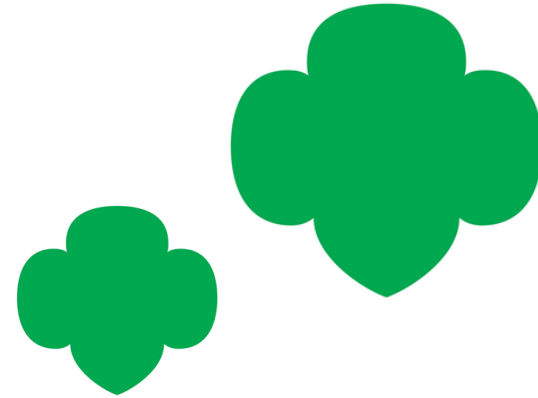
Helpful Table Manners:

- ✚ Thank the host for having you at the party

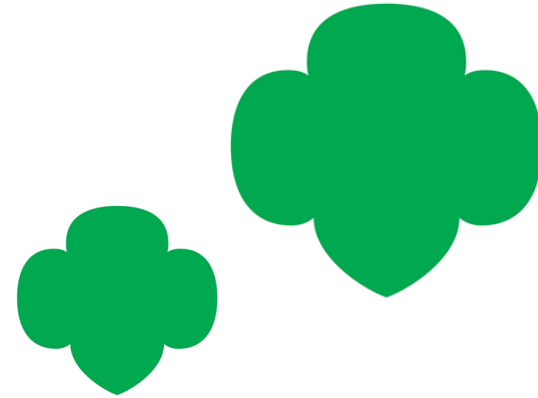


Say Thank You

Can brighten someone's day

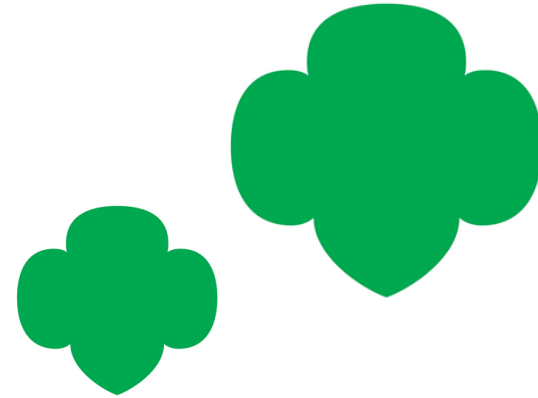

Helpful tip to be at ease

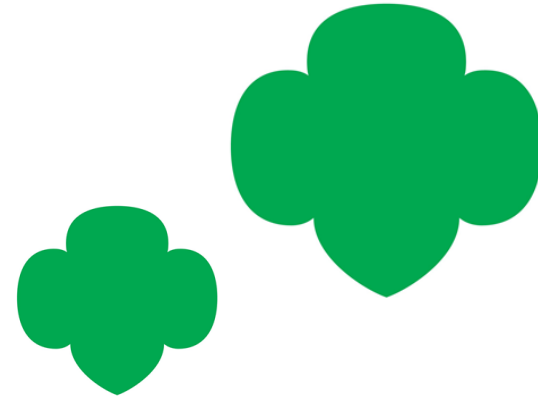
- ✚ Yoga
