Silver Award Example Timeline

Below is an example Silver Award Timeline to help guide you in creating your timeline! Although this is a sample Silver Award timeline, it is helpful for Gold Award Girl Scouts, too, as the timeline is something that is important for both awards.

Please note the following things that MUST be included on your timeline in order for it to be approved:

- 1. Your full name needs to be included in every task you list.
 - In the example below, the girl completing the project is *Grace Burke*.
- 2. If anyone is helping you with a task, their full name needs to be listed:
 - Group member(s) Girl Scouts you are working with that also hope to earn their Silver Award through the completion of this project (if applicable)
 - If completing a project in a Silver Award group, list their names ONLY when they are completing a certain task with you. Do not list tasks that your Silver Award Project group members are completing individually (without you).
 - Core Team Members People that you will lead and train throughout your project. Family members and skilled advisors do not count
 - In the example below, *Grace Burke's* two core team members are *Nick Lepkowski* and *Melissa Pepitone*.
 - o Core Team Members need to be involved in 10 hours of project time
 - Volunteers Any additional helpers, such as family members, advisors, etc.
 - In this example, *Grace Burke's* volunteers are *Mrs. Burke* and *Mr. Burke*.
