Michelle Dech currently serves as the Executive Director of the LGBT Center of Greater Reading. She stepped into the role in 2019 and initiated growth and expansion of programs, services, and outreach to those 7 to 100 years old in Berks and surrounding counties. She earned a Nonprofit Management Certificate from Lasalle University in 2021.

She was appointed as a Commissioner to the Governor's Pennsylvania Commission on LGBTQ+ Affairs, where she works with Commissioners throughout the state on initiatives that promote equity in policy/legislation, healthcare, and education. She serves on the Aging Workgroup for the Commission where she works closely with the Department of Health on initiatives concerning LGBTQ+ elders. She serves on the City of Reading Diversity Board, the Reading Equity Advisory Committee for the Reading School District, the Sexual and Gender Minorities Taskforce for Penn State Health, Hershey, the Healthcare Advisory Committee, and the Chief Juvenile Probation Committee in Berks County.

Before stepping into the role of Executive Director, Michelle was a Regional Manager of a Nationwide Outlet Store division for 28 years. Her territory covered the Northeast and MidAtlantic areas consisting of 11 states, 43 stores and a team of more than 400. She chaired the Diversity and Inclusion Taskforce, improving the integration of diversity into the workplace. In addition, she worked to create a recruiting process that encompassed the company's diversity aspirations through training on topics that included: LGBTQIA+, racism, discrimination, institutional racism, and cultural competency.

Michelle lives in Muhlenberg Township with her wife Debra. She enjoys traveling and exploring new areas, hiking, reading, serving those in need, and spending time with family and friends.
