

Sheila Berg National Chair for Women Veterans Jewish War Veterans United States Air Force, Retired

Sheila Berg serves as the Post Commander of the Jewish War Veterans and raises awareness of the need to support women veterans. She served 29 years in the United States Air Force Reserves, 14 of which she served as a jet engine mechanic at Dover Air Force Base and worldwide. She served in a support assignment at Dover Air Base during the Gulf War and Iraqi Freedom and retired as a Senior Master Sergeant.

Her impressive educational background includes completing her degree from Bennett College in Greensboro, NC in three years, Howard University's School of Social Work, the United States Air Force Academy, United States Air Force Jet Engine Mechanic Technical School, Senior Non-Commissioned Officer Academy, and a Personalist degree from Community College of the Air Force.

She developed a research project at Lehigh Valley Health Network named "Social Work Early Intervention," where social workers would visit Orthopedic pre-surgery patients to evaluate home safety and their environment, with her thesis focused on presenting re-admissions.

In addition, Sheila was a workshop presenter for PA Cancer Plan, where she offered credited instructions for health workers to understand social and emotional issues for cancer patients and families. She was a sisterhood co-chair at a Dover synagogue and is currently a member of the Jewish Federation of the Lehigh Valley Women's Philanthropy Committee.




Mary E. Lisicky, CFP Vice President, Wealth Management, Financial Advisor Morgan Stanley Wealth Management
