## **Activities Available at GSEP Outdoor Centers**

- Each girl will need to have a High-Risk Permission form filled out and signed by a parent or guardian. This form is located on the GSEP website.
- Reservations are only allowed 4 weeks out from the requested reservation date to allow GSEP time to make the arrangements to secure a facilitator.
  We try our best to meet all requests but cannot always guarantee we will be able to secure facilitators for every date.
- What is the difference between the High Challenge Course and the Challenge Tower & Dueling Zipline?
  - High Challenge Course- A traditional high ropes continuous course that has 4 elements. 1 participant at a time.
  - Challenge Tower & Dueling Zip Line- Is a 17 element multi-tier climbing tower. This is an individual course where a participant will make their way through a multi-tier climbing course to reach the top of the challenge tower, where they then will zipline across the lake.
- Do I need to provide an Archery Facilitator or will GSEP Provide one?
  - GSEP will help coordinate securing a facilitator if a troop does not have a certified archery instructor. Prior to the reservation date, troops must provide the name and certification of the volunteer facilitating the activity.
- Do I need to pay my Facilitator(s)?
  - Archery and Boating are the only two activities that GSEP recommends troops paying the facilitator separately from the equipment rental fee. The rental fee is part of the booking system and separate from the facilitator payment. Paying your facilitator via check, is best for a paper trail and end of year troop financial records.
- Where do I go for my scheduled activity?

## **Activities Available at GSEP Outdoor Centers**

 Troops should meet at the location of the activity to greet their scheduled facilitator. If you are unsure where the location is, you should call the property ranger for guidance.

## • How will I know if I have a facilitator scheduled?

 GSEP will send out an email the Monday prior to your reservation to inform you of the status. If we are unable to secure a facilitator for your activity, you will receive a full refund.
