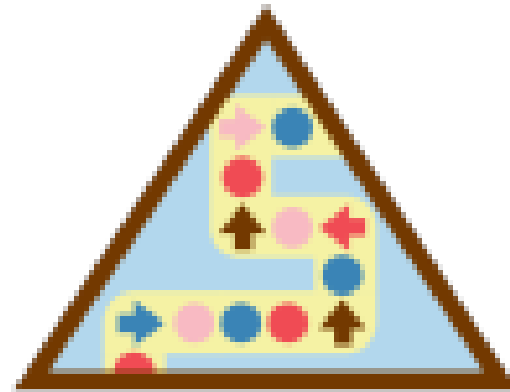

Scout Law.



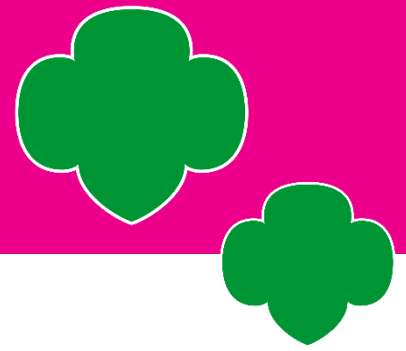
Girl Scout Law

Algorithm: list of steps to complete a task



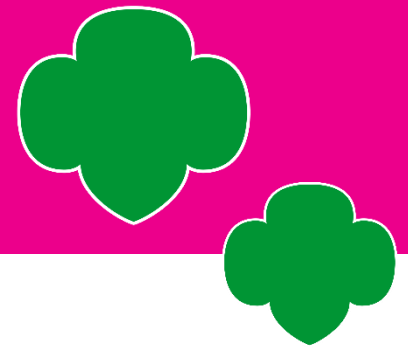

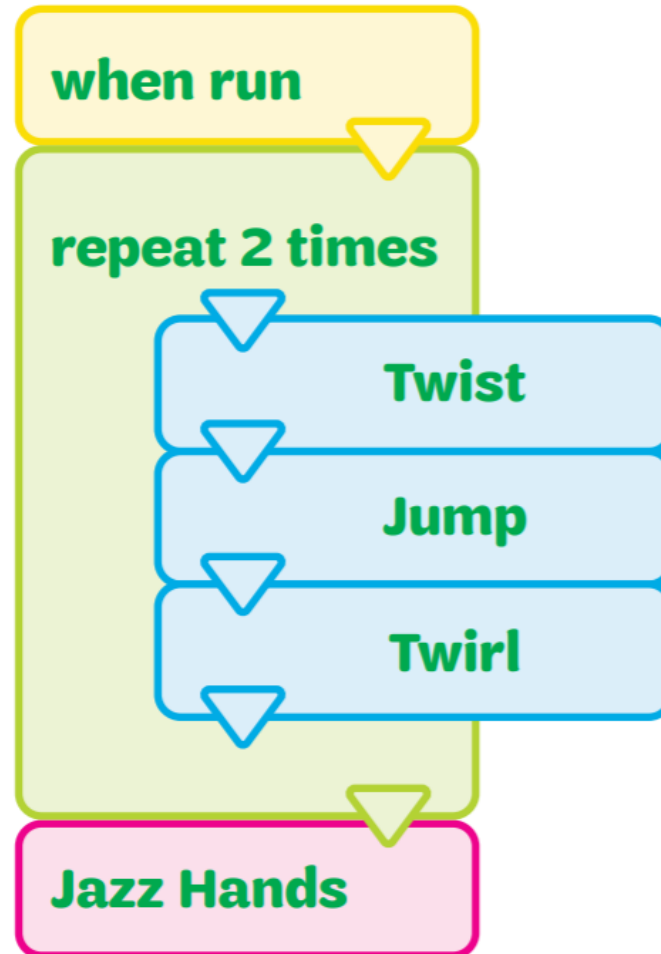

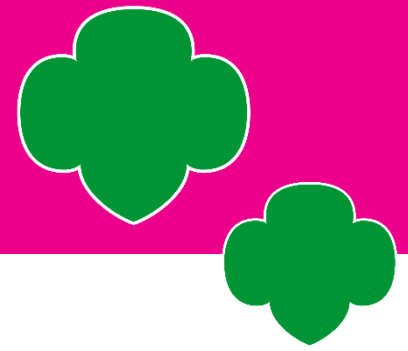
When I clap my hands... take a tiny step to the side
