

By the Numbers: Silver vs. Gold

Wondering about numerical requirements for the Silver and Gold Awards? Look no further – here are all of the important values you should know as you plan your project and build your timeline!

Topic	Silver Award	Gold Award
Minimum # of project hours required	50	80
Maximum # of girls who can work together on a project	2-4	1
Minimum # of non-related, core team members that must be recruited & trained for the project team (core team members should be peers)	2	5
Maximum # of hours for completing paperwork (including both proposal and final) that can be counted towards project hours	5	5
Maximum # of hours of collection that can be counted towards project hours	5	5
Maximum # of hours of <u>planning</u> a fundraiser (execution time cannot be counted) OR for doing small collection of items that can be counted towards project hours	5	5
Minimum # of hours core team members must help with the project (also known as leadership hours – can include time for training core team and leading them)	10	10
Minimum # of people who must be served by the program or benefit from the project	10	10
Minimum # of program implementation hours required (these hours do not include time spent training the volunteer team, nor does it include the time needed to set up and clean up for the program)	7-10	10-12
Maximum # of pre-approval hours which can be counted toward the required project hours	10	15
