Have you filled out the Hours Log that includes the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 80 hours minimum? • Hours broken down into small chunks of no more than 2-3 hours? • No more than 20% of your hours are completed prior to approval of your project? 	
Have you created a comprehensive budget that includes ALL supplies you will need to complete your project (including those you already own or will borrow), and a plan for offsetting the expenses?	
Does your plan include steps for collecting permission slips, photo release forms, and allergy information (i.e., food allergies if snacks will be served) for those under 18 years old who will participate in your project? (See GSEP Volunteer Essentials)	
Does your project follow Safety Activity Checkpoints for all activities you have planned?	
Have you reviewed the Money Earning Guidelines and understand what types of donations you can seek for your project?	

If you can check all boxes above, you are ready to submit your Proposal and checklist in GoGold. A council representative will be in touch to schedule a time for you to meet with the Gold Award Committee to present your plans and receive feedback.

You may not, under any circumstances, begin the Take Action part of your project (Step 6) until you receive approval from your Gold Coach and GSEP.
