

## CALLING ALL GIRL BOSSES Gold Award Submission Timeline 2024-2025



Girls who follow this timeline will meet requirements to earn their Gold Award by May 2025 and will be recognized at GirlzDay: Our World, Our Way.

Workshop #4	Saturday, November 16	<b>Proposal Prep</b> Girls work on proposals – including SMART goals, timeline, and budget.
Workshop #5	Saturday, December 7	<b>Proposal Submission Deadline</b> By this date, girls submit their proposals via Rallyhood or email to girlbosses@gsep.org. Girls may also turn in a handwritten proposal at Workshop #5.
	December 7-21	<b>Girls Receive Proposal Feedback</b> Feedback on girls' proposals will be sent from Highest Awards coaches via email.
	December 22- January 4	<b>Girls Make Revisions to Proposals</b> Girls update their proposals to address feedback.
	January 4	<b>Proposal Revision Deadline</b> Girls resubmit their proposals on Rallyhood or by email. If girls need to submit a handwritten version, they can turn it in at Workshop #6.
Workshop #6	Saturday, January 11	<b>Girls Receive Project Approval</b> (or receive additional feedback) By this date, girls will receive an email from a Highest Awards coach confirming that their proposal is approved along with a list of coaches who will support them.
Workshops #7-10	January 12- April 1	<b>Project Implementation / Journeys</b> Girls start working on their projects! Girls should plan to spend at least 15 hours per month in January, February, and March on their projects (45 hours total, not counting CAGB workshops). Girls will earn their Bliss and Citizen Scientist Journeys in March.
	Wednesday, April 2	<b>Final Report Deadline</b> Girls submit their final reports via Rallyhood or email. Girls who want to submit a handwritten copy should contact a Highest Awards coach or CAGB staff.
	April 2- April 12	<b>Girls Receive Final Report Feedback</b> CAGB Staff and Highest Awards coaches will review final reports and will send girls feedback by email.
	Saturday, April 19	<b>Revised Final Report Deadline</b> Girls resubmit their revised final reports.
Workshop #11	Saturday, April 26	<b>Girls Receive Final Approval of Project Reports</b> (or additional feedback) By this date, girls will receive an email confirming their project has been approved.
	April 28- May 10	<b>Gold Award Final Interviews</b> Girl will schedule a 30-minute interview with the Highest Award committee to talk about their project.
	Saturday, May 17	<b>GirlzDay: Our World, Our Way</b> Girls who have earned their award will receive their pin and will be recognized at GirlzDay along with other Highest Awards earners from across the council!
