

Important FAQ's

Camp Site Availability Schedule:

Rentals for January-May open for troops in mid-October

Rentals for September- December open for troops in mid-May.

GSEP Holiday Schedule for Camp Sites:

Thanksgiving Weekend- CLOSED

Christmas Week-CLOSED

MLK Day Weekend-OPEN

Easter Weekend- CLOSED

Memorial Day-OPEN

July 4th- N/A GSEP Summer Camp in session

Labor Day Weekend-CLOSED

Cancelation Policy:

Cancelations must be submitted and received 4 weeks prior to the reserved date by emailing memberservices@gsep.org in order to receive a full refund.

Clearances for Renting a Campsite:

All Adults attending overnight camporees and troop camping must be registered members of GSEP and have completed the GSEP Criminal Background Clearance Process.

Men at Camp:

Safety Activity Checkpoints requires that men stay in separate sleeping quarters and with separate designated restroom facilities when they camp with girls. It is MANDATORY to communicate with GSEP prior to making any reservations when men will be present at the camp. Pitching of additional tents, and the use of campers is prohibited.

Approval for Overnight Camping Trips:

All overnight trips need to be approved by the Service Unit Manager and GSEP Council.

Prohibited from GSEP Properties:

- No pets are allowed in any GSEP facilities except for certified service animals.
- Illegal drugs and weapons of any kind are not allowed at our sites and facilities.
- Alcohol is not permitted on any GSEP property without a written contract and additional insurance purchase. Arrangements must be in writing and are at the discretion of GSEP.

Facilitators for activities:

GSEP will provide a facilitator for all adventure activities and communicate if any changes or cancelations need to be made prior to your reservation.

Check in and Check out for Troop Camping:

Check-in is from 2pm-8pm

Check-out must occur before 12pm.
