JLS 2024 will empower up to 500 young women (aged 18 to 30) around the world with the leadership practices, global perspectives, and a peer support network to take the lead in their lives and act on their values to bring positive social change to their world.

Participants must be:

- An active member of GSUSA
- A member of the Global Leadership Opportunities (GLO pool). If you are not currently a member of the GLO pool, please complete this <u>application</u> <u>and council endorsement</u> and submit with your Juliette Low Seminar application.
- Age 18-30 by March 1, 2024
- Able to understand and communicate well in one of the following: Arabic, English, French, Spanish.
- Attend an in-person event at a World Center in Ghana, India, or Mexico September 29 -4 October 2024.
- Adaptable, culturally sensitive, and open minded.
- Willing to undertake new and challenging experiences.
- Mature and responsible global citizen who is interested in leadership development, international friendships and willingness to learn from a global program.
- Applicants must apply and be accepted by GSUSA before being considered by WAGGGS.

Event details:

- This event will be **hybrid** and will launch online in April 2024.
- **April -June 2024:** Participants will be on Campfire (WAGGGS' digital home) for three months of e-learning courses and patrol meetings. (Time commitment: 7 hours per month)
- **July September 2024:** Participants will begin 100 Girls Projects. Local activations to empower at least 100 girls. (Time commitment: 10 hours a month developing 100 girls project.)
- **29 of September to 5 October**: Participants attend an in-person event at Nuestra (Mexico), Kusafiri (Ghana) or Sangam (India).
- **October -December 2024**: Participants continue their 100 Girls Project and attend the JLS 2024 Closing Party in December.
