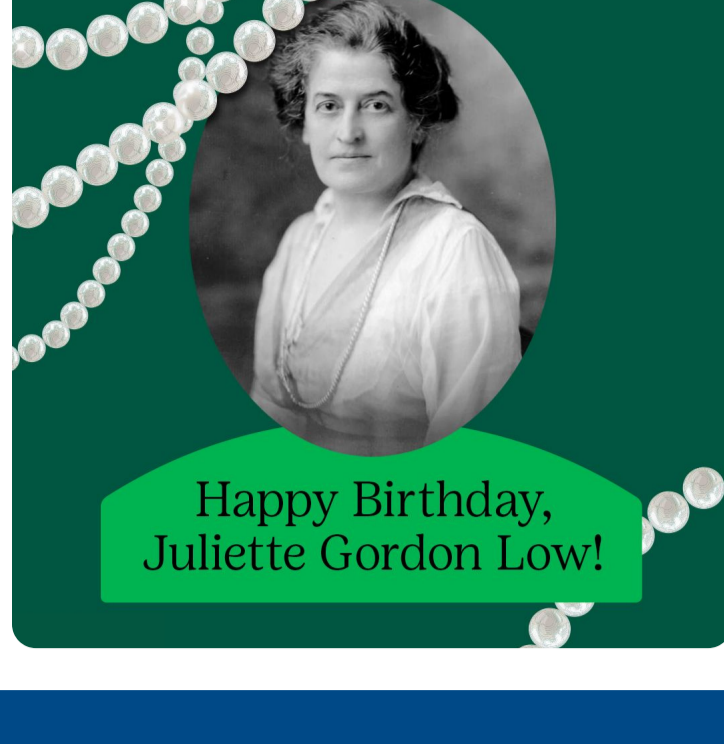

### WAGGGS World Center Pax Lodge, London, England



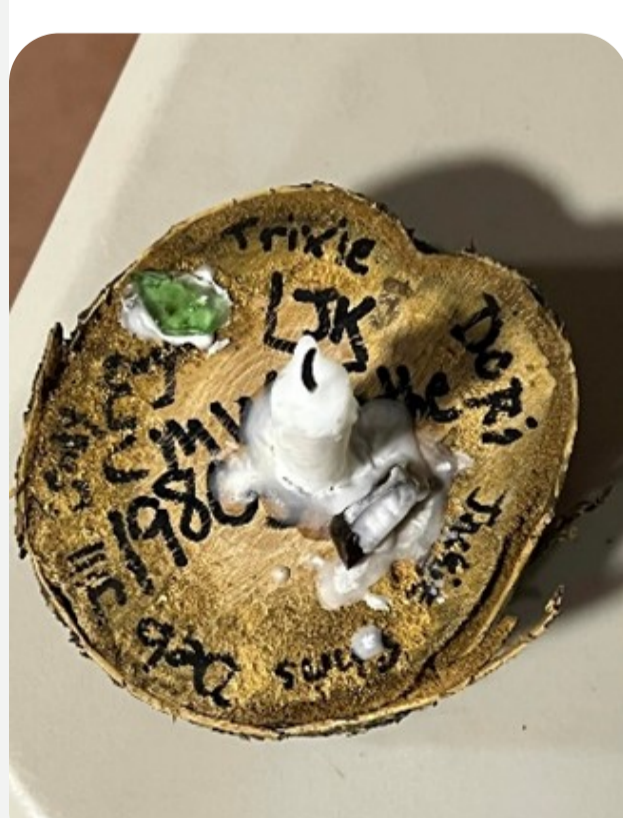

### Camp Anniversaries

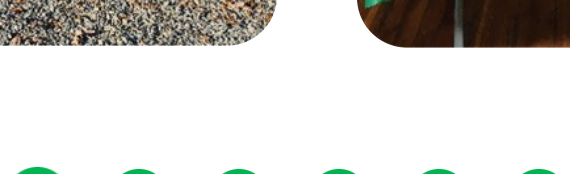


Both Camp Mosey Wood and Camp Wood Haven celebrated anniversaries this Fall.
