Some distinctive highlights of the meeting were the presentation of this year's Governance Award, a special acknowledgement of our outgoing Girl Advisors, the election of four new Board members, and a special good-bye presentation to Debbie Hassan, our Board Chair for the past six years.

Board Chair Debbie Hassan and CEO Kim Fraites-Dow shared national governance news from GSUSA, including an announcement of Girl Scouts of the USA's new National CEO, Bonnie Barczykowski. Board Development Committee ("BDC") Chair Debbie O'Brien and BDC member Deb Walters

This past March, the Delegate Council meeting focused on the upcoming

National Council Session ("NCS").

presented a report on the work of the BDC this governance year as well as an overview of the comparative demographic data of the applicants and nominees for Girl Advisors and Girl Delegates. Also, the 2023 NCS Delegates and Alternates facilitated the Strategy Café discussions on the seven proposal topics that will be voted on in July: 1. Allowing virtual attendance at National Council meetings and allowing Official Notices to be delivered electronically

2. Amending the GS Promise & Law by deleting the words "try" in the Promise and "do my best" in the Law 3. Changing the timing of NCS Delegate allotment (i.e., the number of NCS

- Delegates allotted to each Council will be determined by girl membership two years before NCS, rather than the current year preceding NCS)
- 4. Changing the formula for determining the number of NCS Delegates (from the current formula of one Delegate for every 3,500 girls to one Delegate for every 1,000 girls)

5. Having at least three Council CEOs serve on the National Board of

- Directors 6. Affirming the creation of a Gold Award Scholarship Fund by including it in the Blue Book 7. Adding the words "anti-racism" to the Preamble of GSUSA's Constitution
- to emphasize that our Movement advances diversity, pluralism and antiracism
