<u>Why is training necessary/strongly encouraged for Delegates?</u>

However, what *is* required is the ability to think strategically and understand not only how decisions are made for the Council but also how those decisions may impact individuals, troops, and the Council as a whole... positively or negatively (which can then change the conclusion of whether a change needs to be made or not).

How does a person develop that ability? First, Delegates should be familiar with our fundamental guidelines and policies (e.g., our Bylaws, GSUSA's Blue Book, etc.); this does not mean you have to memorize those documents, but rather you should know they exist so we can reference a common set of rules.

A governance role is a little different from being a Troop Cookie Manager or Troop Leader or even a future Gold Award Girl Scout. There are not a lot of

also requires talking to other Delegates and hearing different opinions and coming to a consensus, since Girl Scouting has been a democratic organization for most of its existence (starting with the first National Council Session in 1915).
